

We do our best to cover all situations. Bring a lunch, snacks, sunscreen (players must reapply their own), water bottle, and anything else needed, such as clothing layers. We will have supplies for minor medical issues (cuts and scrapes), ice and water.

Since North French is wide open, we will have a large tent for shelter

"In case of rain we have tents, tables and chairs set up to take shelter.

In case of an intermittent storm, there is a church across the road that we will seek shelter in the rear parking area. The let us use their community room.

In case of a longer storm/torrential rain/lightning, we will have to cancel the day and ask for family or emergency pickup of every camper. If we know the weather will be bad at drop off in the morning, we may relocate indoors to the Village Glen or the NARC. Every family must give us a phone number that facilitates and emergency text for these situations. In a quick severe thunderstorm that requires immediate shelter, we will attempt to locate to the gymnastic center next door for a short time or to await pickups.
